APL is a community hub - More than 48,000 people attended over 1,100 programs in 2023. These included author talks, and programs for preschool and school-aged, teen, ESL, health & wellness, and Makerspace, and events like Mighty Machines Day, Family Literacy Day, and Snowflake Follies.

APL is growing - From 2022 to 2023 we saw an 8% increase in membership from 26,480 to 28,519. 202,209 people walked through our doors, an increase of 17%, and we saw a 7% increase in checkouts, finishing the year with 625,120 items having gone out into the community.
